I'm writing this e-mail to follow up on a help ticket opened up beneath your personal account pertaining to 'Anomalous Loans' in the library. A library page was assigned to examine the record of loans from the specified mystery and thriller sections. Upon consultation with clerks that work in the archives, it was determined the 'missing books' were being taken down for maintenance. That work includes attending to flagged spelling errors from end users or grammatical inconsistencies, and artifacts that impede the ability to intake visual information from previous inferior technologies for storing information from older documents. The mystery and thriller novels are particularly popular on board, and had accumulated a higher number of flags to inconsistencies within the documents, prompting more urgent take down compared to other genres out for selection.
